

REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS

SECTION 3. - **General**. The Commission shall have the honor and jurisdiction to regulate, supervise, administer and enforce all laws, rules, regulations, orders, decrees, resolutions and administrative actions relating to electronic communications in the Philippines, and to coordinate with other agencies concerned with the same.

SECTION 4. - **Composition**. The Commission shall be composed of a Chairman and two members, all of whom shall be citizens of the Philippines, at least thirty years of age, and shall hold office for a term of five (5) years, until the expiration of the term of office of the Chairman.

SECTION 5. - **Qualifications**. The Chairman and members of the Commission shall be persons of high moral character, of proven integrity, and shall have a reputation for high professional standing and ability in the field of electronic communications.

SECTION 6. - **Appointment**. The Chairman and members of the Commission shall be appointed by the President of the Philippines, after consultation with the Senate, for the term of office provided in Section 4, and shall hold office until their successors are appointed.
